

DPCA ~ IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE (2009 – 2010)

~Here is an immunization schedule 'at a glance' so you can quickly determine if your child is up to date for their grade. Please be careful to acquire all the required doses **before** your student enters school.

*** disease history from a health care provider, parent/guardian is acceptable for Varicella

MMR1= Measles, Mumps, Rubella ~ 1st dose

MMR2= Measles, Mumps, Rubella ~ 2nd dose

HB3= Hepatitis B series of 3 doses

VAR = Varicella or Chickenpox.....{2 doses required for K, 1st, 2nd ; 1 dose for 3rd - 9th}

DTP-5= Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis ~ 5 doses (+ one dose Tdap (6th,7th,8th,10th,11th grade)

POLIO-4= Polio ~ 4 doses

You have the right to have your child exempted from these immunizations based on :

Medical Exemption: must be signed by a physician stating that the immunizations would endanger student's life or health;

Religious Exemption: must be signed by a parent or guardian stating religious belief opposed to immunizations;

Personal Exemptions: must be signed by a parent or guardian stating personal belief opposed to immunizations;

However, in the event of an outbreak, exempted persons may be subject to exclusion from school & quarantine.
