We want to thank every student, parent, teacher and Promotions Committee member for providing DPCA with another successful FALL FEST!!

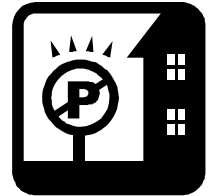
The booths were fun, the stage games intense, (Jason Metzgar emcee extraordinaire!), the food delicious and our guests the best.
