Darren Patterson Christian Academy's general high school curriculum and course progression is noted below. Classes or categories of classes in regular type are required for all students; classes noted in *italics* are electives to be chosen by the individual student and his or her parents. There are four class blocks available on alternating days. Traditional classroom classes are offered in alternating years. For example, a student who takes English and World Literature the freshman year would take English and Literary Themes the sophomore year, and vice-versa.
